

Seven Times

In a webinar video by Elisabeth Urbanowitz called *Making the Bible More Kid Friendly?** she stresses the importance of knowing God's word in its entirety and as a complete narrative. She talks about how the average child needs 7 exposures to the same content before it becomes part of their daily thought process and creates neurological pathways in their brain. Think about this, our children need at least 7 exposures to the complete narrative of God's word (the entire Bible) to begin to truly understand how it all comes together. Let's also think about this in the potential negative. What other content have our children been exposed to at least 7 times that may be forming thoughts and beliefs that go against scripture? Is there more exposure to this sort of content than the truth of the Bible?

Our Covenant Kids class has been working through the book of Genesis and are now into Exodus, building a foundation from the beginning of the word. But let me put this out there as a challenge for kids and parents: if we want to be experts in God's word to us, let's aim for getting in 7 exposures to the entire Bible. There's many Bible reading plans available, paper and digital. It will take time and dedication, but the blessing and richness of faith and knowledge of God and His character that will follow is exciting to think about!
